Why is MCERTS important?

MCERTS, is a product certification scheme operated by the CSA Group on behalf of the UK's Environment Agency (EA).

The MCERTS for Indicative Ambient Particulate
Monitors involves rigorous field and laboratory tests to
demonstrate a product's performance requirements
compliance, as well as a manufacturing audit to assess
the Management System used for the manufacture of
the product. This certification is particularly pertinent to
air quality monitoring, where the delivery of accurate
and defensible data is paramount for environmental
impact assessment and regulatory compliance.

Ways to Purchase Airly

There are no more costs beyond the annual subscription, which includes data costs for the SIM, replacement sensor if its ever needed and a subscription to SvanNET.

You can prepay the first year by purchasing our initial one year subscription and then after that you just need to purchase an annual renewal.

Our initial one year subscription includes the following:

- The Airly PM sensor units
- A data SIM card for a year
- Use of the Airly API to transfer data to SvanNET
- SvanNET subscription for a year

You can prepay for 2 years or 4 years. Then at the end of that period you will need to purchase an annual renewal. If you require an alternative time frame, please let us know, as this can be adapted.
